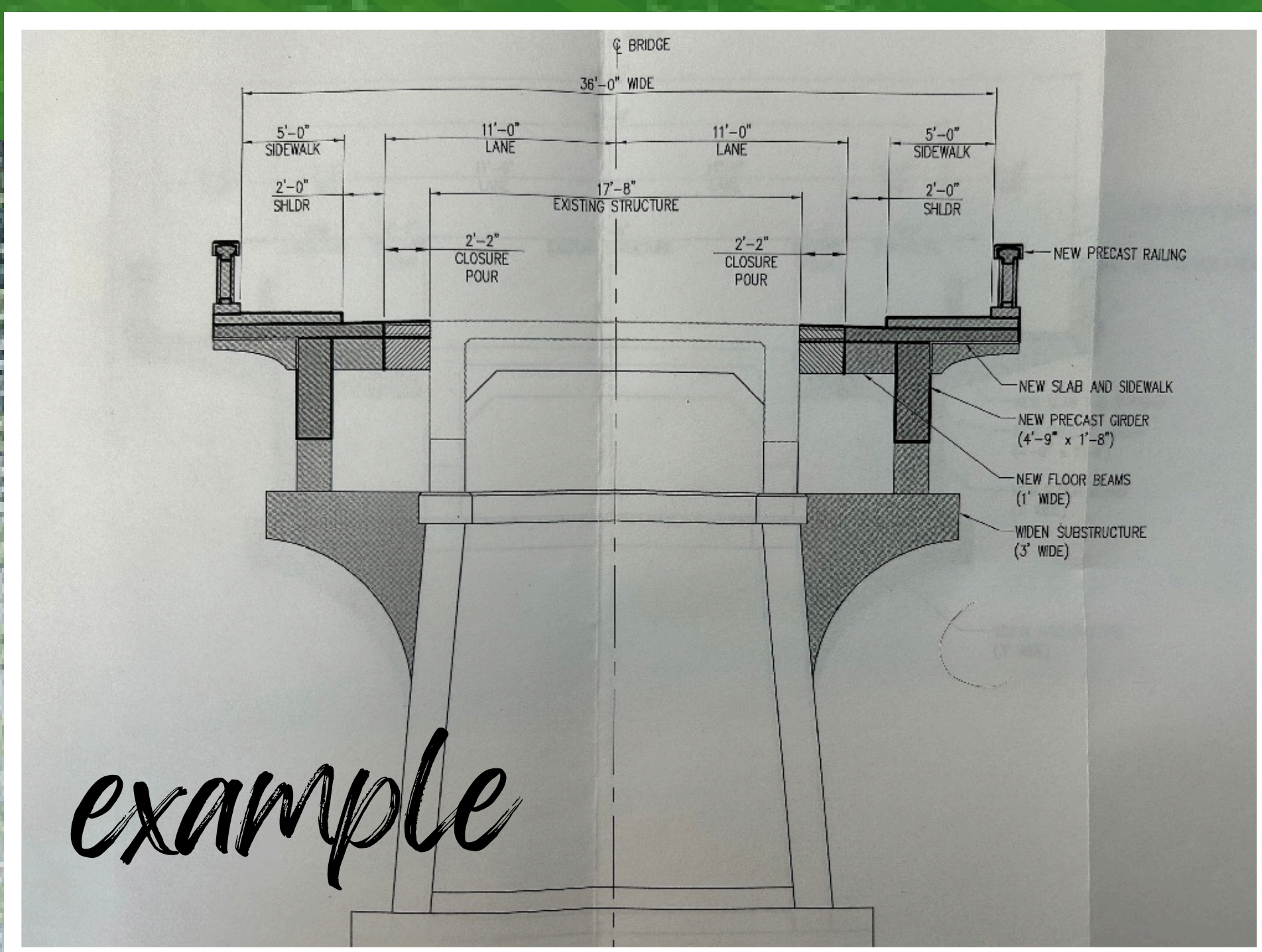


\$8 MILLION

TWO-WAY BRIDGE

This project would modify the Woodin Avenue Bridge to accomodate two-way traffic and 6ft sidewalks on both sides while maintaining the historical beauty of the bridge.



\$1 MILLION

REVERSE BRIDGE DIRECTION

This project would reverse the direction of the bridge out of town to alleviate the build-up of traffic coming into downtown Chelan and move cars off Johnson Ave. between Columbia and Sanders St.



\$2 MILLION

STREET PRESERVATION

As a first priority for our TBD funds, we would invest 2 Million over 10 years on street preservation. Street preservation efforts are 10x less expensive than replacing streets. Rather than costly street replacement, street preservation—such as crack sealing, seal coating, and pavement overlays—helps extend the life of Chelan's roadways.

LAKESIDE PARKING

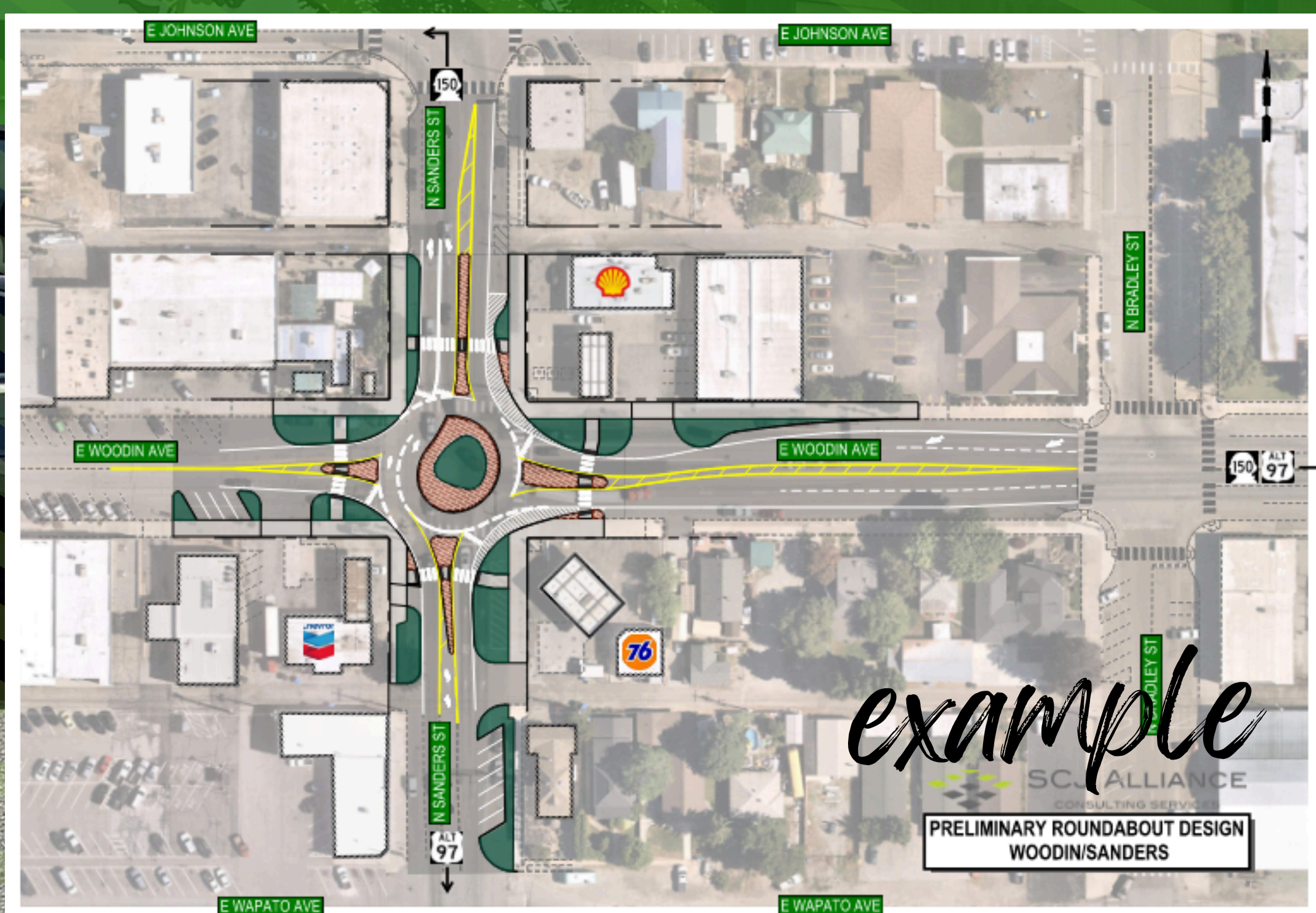
Conceptually this project would create additional parking capacity in the Lakeside Park and adjacent neighborhoods by developing clearly marked spaces, appropriate signage, and improved pedestrian access within the existing public right-of-way in surrounding area.



\$4 MILLION

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

This project facilitates the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Woodin Ave. and Sanders St. The preliminary design and shape of the roundabout has been approved by WSDOT, simplifying future design efforts and increasing the fund-ability of the project. A roundabout at this location is projected to improve traffic efficiency and safety, as well as increase pedestrian safety.



\$1 MILLION

CROSSWALKS

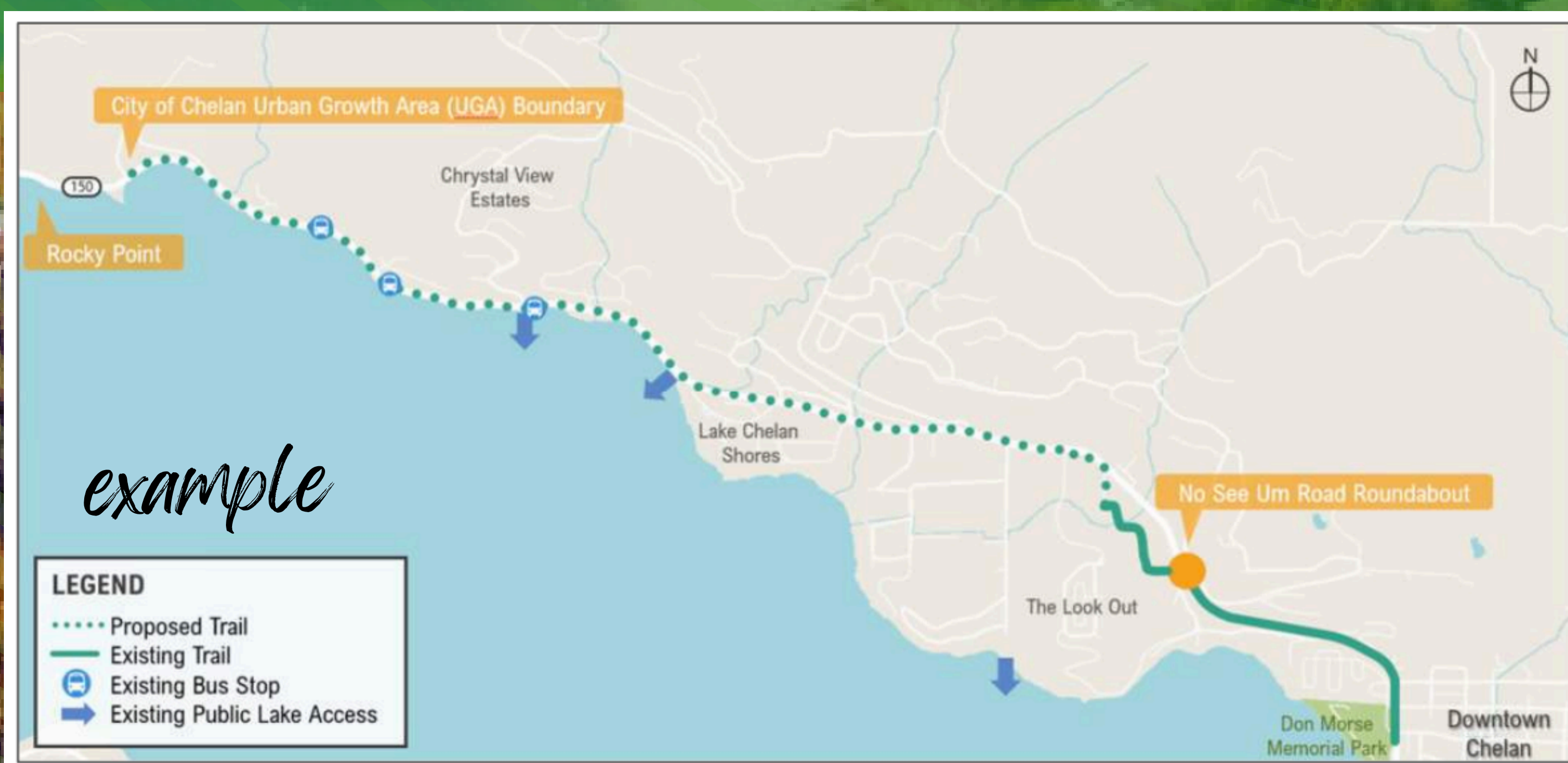
This project would focus on improving pedestrian safety by implementing sidewalks where they are needed and currently do not exist or are insufficient



\$4 MILLION

NORTHSHORE TRAIL

This project facilitates the extension of the existing multi-use trail that currently terminates at Bighorn Way in North Chelan. This project would include the design and construction of this multi-use trail extending from its current location at lengths that match funding would facilitate.



\$2 MILLION

SIDEWALK UPGRADES

This project would facilitate the construction of sidewalks in areas that currently lack them. This project would generally target the Downtown, South Chelan, and Lakeside neighborhoods.
