

MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 25, 2015 SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
135 E Johnson Avenue, Chelan, Washington

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Goedde called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

ELECTED OFFICIALS PRESENT: Mayor Goedde, Councilmembers Cooney, Harper, Higgins, Isenhardt, McCardle, Morehouse, and Steele.

STAFF PRESENT: City Administrator Schmidt, Finance Director Grant, Planning Director Gildroy, and Public Works Director Van Epps.

2. DISCUSSION

Angie Walagorski, presented the parking study conducted by RH2 Engineering. Councilmembers reviewed various discussion points including:

1. Proposal to make all parking time limits in the Downtown at three (3) hours maximum. Currently it is a mix of two hours on Woodin Avenue and three (3) hours on Emerson.
2. Proposal to establish Downtown Parking enforcement "season" from third (3rd) Monday in May to the second (2nd) Monday in September.
3. Proposal to convert former PUD Parking Lot parking limits from three (3) hours of free parking to pay parking similar to the Don Morse Parking lot. Suggestion is to adopt a consistent fee for all pay parking lots in the amount of \$1 per hour.
4. Proposal to remove four (4) 15 minute parking stalls on Woodin Avenue and replace with standard parking.
5. Proposal to convert Lakeside Parking Lot from free all day parking to pay parking similar to the Don Morse Parking lot.
6. Proposal to allow overnight parking at Lakeside Park adjacent to Lakeside Lodge with a paid permit system.
7. Proposal to include more summer weekend security at Lakeside Park for parking and boat use.
8. Proposal to restripe Marina Parking lot to allow longer vehicle/trailer parking.
9. Proposal to revise Chelan Municipal Code Chapter 10.36 for consistency updates.

3. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 7: 55 p.m.
