This Contract provides for the improvement of traffic movements along Highway 150 between E Johnson Avenue and Woodin Avenue (US 97A). To complete this work the Contractor will need to perform pavement marking removal, pavement marking installation, permanent signing, traffic control and other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications.

At the time and date stated above, the sealed proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud via Zoom meeting due to COVID 19 protocols.
