Please help us keep the Recycling Containers Available!

Take a little time to learn how it works . . .

- Read and follow directions on the recycling container.
- Do not leave unwanted items. Flatten cardboard and plastics.
- Put properly prepared items in the correct bins.
- Do not leave items outside the container.
- Bring larger loads to the Recycling Center Facility.
- Please only correct plastic types.

NO STYROFOAM of any kind should ever be left at the recycle containers or at the recycle center. (Clean) Styrofoam peanuts are currently accepted at the Lake Chelan Mail Boxes - 682-1303.

NEWSPAPER/MAGAZINES/GLOSSY PAPER: Slick/glossy paper & junk mail. Please remove bags.

CRAFT PAPER/CORRUGATED BOARD: (Look for wavy layer).

ALSO: Cereal Boxes (remove inside packaging), 6 pack holders, brown wrapping paper and grocery bags etc. NO plastic lined dog food bags or cement bags.

MIXED PAPER: Office paper, scrap or waste paper, non-glossy junk mail, computer paper, etc. Clean: NO food particles, soiled tissue or napkins.

GLASS BOTTLES/JARS: Remove lids; labels OK. Please rinse. Sort by color.

NO light bulbs, dishes, windows, drinking glasses, ceramics.

ALUMINUM CANS: Also clean aluminum pie pans and foil, etc.

Separate cans from foil and pie plates, etc.

COPPER/BRASS: Also insulated copper & aluminum wire, aluminum scrap, stainless steel.

Cash paid for aluminum, copper and brass.

TIN CANS: Remove label, clean & rinse.

PLASTIC P.E.T.E. BOTTLES & JARS: , any color. Rinse, crush, lids left on are okay.

PLASTIC MILK JUGS: And all clear . Remove top, rinse, crush. **NO** # oil & chemical bottles.

COLORED SCREW-TOP : **NO** auto oil containers, chemical bottles, microwave dishes.

MILK & JUICE CARTONS & ASEPTIC CONTAINERS accepted! **NO** straws.

Rinse and crush. Put in "cardboard section" at drop off stations.

USED MOTOR OIL: Bring used oil in 1 or 5 gallon containers to the Chelan School Bus Garage.

MOTOR OIL/ANTIFREEZE(DO NOT MIX): Transfer Station - FREE Drop Off. Less than 5 gal.

TIRES: For recycling - \$3 charge and up - Les Schwab - 682-4567

AUTO BATTERIES: Take to Les Schwab.

Plastic bags, bubble pads, shrink wrap: please enclose in plastic bags.

NO dog food bags, freezer bags, woven plastic bags.

METAL ITEMS now accepted at Recycle Center
(NO Refrigerators or Air Conditioners).

REFRIGERATORS & AIR CONDITIONERS

accepted for fee at Transfer Station, Rowe's Towing or Fragnitos Recycling.

NEW! E-CYCLE WASHINGTON: Accepting computers (CPU/Tower), Laptops, iPads, Monitors, TVs.

• **ALSO Accepting:** extension cords, x-mas lights, computer printers, keyboards, mice, electric motors, stereo receivers, VCR's, CD/DVD/BlueRay Players, dish receivers, any cords.

UNWANTED ITEMS FOR RECYCLING . . . Items we **cannot** recycle

- # Oil & Chemical Bottles
- Plastic Toys, Sleds, etc.
- Plastic #s , , , ,
- Styrofoam peanuts, Styrofoam packaging
- Cement Bags, Plastic Lined Dog Food Bags
- Wet or soiled paper, napkins, tissues, etc.
- Dry cell batteries

Leaves & Brush (6" diameter & under) Only

Separate leaves & brush - Enter and pay at Transfer Station (not recycle center).

What Can You Do?

- Composting yard waste & food scraps makes better soil, uses less water.
- **LEARN NOT TO BURN!** Leaves make good soil. Composting Info call 682-4663
- Packaging - avoid when possible
- Bulk - buy in large quantities.
- Bags - Reuse, then Recycle.
- Avoid single-use items.
- Paper - use both sides, then recycle.
- Batteries - use rechargeable
- Rags instead of paper.
- Diapers - use cloth.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE ALTERNATIVES

1. Ants (in house): sprinkle ground cloves.
2. Bleach Alternative: Borax, use only when necessary.
3. Car battery corrosion: baking soda and water
4. Cleaners (general household): 1 tsp liquid soap + 1 tsp borax + 1 squeeze of lemon in quart of warm water.
5. Linoleum floor cleaner: 1 cup white vinegar in 2 gallons water.
6. Toilet bowl cleaner: baking soda
7. Tub & tile cleaner: 1/4 cup baking soda + 1/2 cup white vinegar in warm water
8. Dishes & Clothes: use phosphate free dish & laundry soap.
9. Window: 1/8 cup vinegar + 1 cup water in spray bottle

Energy Conservation Tips

1. Purchase energy saving appliances & compact fluorescent lights
2. Turn off hot water heater when away for 3 days or more.
3. Turn down temperature on hot water tank to 120 degrees F.
4. Defrost freezers & refrigerators when ice builds up more than 1/4"
5. Install foam gaskets behind electric outlets and switch plate covers.
6. Use a clothes line for drying your clothes.
7. Turn off lights when not needed.
8. Turn off computer accessories when not in use.
9. Use a microwave for small cooking tasks (75% less energy).
10. Use natural lighting.
11. Install low-flow showerheads or flow restrictors.
